Deposit and Cancellation Policies: A credit card is necessary to hold reservations. One (1) night's room and tax will be held as a deposit. Individual guestroom deposits will be refunded if reservations are cancelled seventy-two (72) hours prior to arrival date. An early departure fee of one (1) night's room and tax will be assessed if a guest departs the Hotel prior to the indicated date at check-in.

Airport and Transportation

The Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport (Airport Code: MSY) is approximately 30 minutes from The Hotel Monteleone. *Taxi service* for one or two persons is approximately \$33 (exclusive of gratuities) between the airport and the Hotel. There is an additional \$12 fee / person for additional passengers beyond two. Taxis may be picked up on the lower level of the airport, outside the baggage claim area.

Shuttle service is also available with *Airport Shuttle New Orleans* for approximately \$20 / person one-way or \$38 / person roundtrip (exclusive of gratuities). Driving Directions

Head I-10 East toward New Orleans Business District and Slidell. Exit on Superdome/Poydras Street (Exit 234B). Proceed down the ramp and continue straight for 8 blocks, staying in the left-hand lane. Turn left onto Camp Street, and continue 4 blocks to Canal Street (a big 2-way Boulevard). Cross over Canal Street, which turns into Chartres Street (in the French Quarter). Go 2 blocks on Chartres Street, and turn left on Bienville Street. The garage entrance for The Hotel Monteleone is located half way down the street and on the left-hand side.

Attire

Business casual is the appropriate attire for most of the conference. A sports jacket for men is recommended for Friday's NAWLA General Session and Regional Meeting.
